A successful timber harvest starts with you:

These two workshops will help you as a landowner better understand the “ins and outs” of a successful timber harvest in your woods. Register for one or both workshops. The first workshop will visit an active harvest on the Evans Tree Farm in Derby; and the second workshop will visit an active harvest at Sterling College in Craftsbury. Participants will gain increased understanding of how to set up a successful harvest and the responsibilities of those involved. Discussion will cover contracts, silviculture and everything in between.

Option 1: Visit an active harvest in Derby. See a cut-to-length harvester working with a forwarder on a certified Tree Farm.

March 10th, 2018: 1PM to 3PM:

Option 2: Visit a small scale, low impact harvest at Sterling College in Craftsbury. See horses and oxen working in the woods and discuss challenges and tradeoffs of working at a smaller scale.
