WALK IN THE WOODS OFFERED IN WASHINGTON COUNTY

Vermont Woodlands announces it's next Walk in the Woods tour on Sunday, November 1, 2009 from 10:30AM to 2:00PM at the Lord's Hill Natural Area, Old Growth Forest, in Marshfield, VT.

The guide for the day will be Charles Cogbill, an independent Forest Ecologist associated with The Harvard College Forest and Sterling College. The property is considered to be a "Big Tree Site" or "Old Growth Forest." This is a moderate hike where participants will view and discuss the history of Lord's Hill Natural Area and Lord's Hill Forest, plans for the future of the Natural Area, and talk about the importance of "Old Growth."
