FAIRLEE - Vermont Woodlands would like to announce that they are sponsoring their 3rd Annual Forestry School Weekend Workshop on “How to Manage Your Forest.” If you want to be a good steward for your forestland this is the course for you to learn land management. The workshop will be held April 18-19, 2008 at the Hulbert Outdoor Center in Fairlee, VT. The workshop will begin at 8:30 AM on Saturday (registration) and will continue until 3:00 PM on Sunday. Registration is required.

Subjects covered during the weekend will include: Forest Inventory and Condition Analysis; Harvesting Forest Products; County Foresters And What They Do; as well as Wildlife And Managing Forests For Wildlife. On Saturday participants will take a walking tour of Hulbert Outdoor Center’s forest and then hear about the Vermont Tree Farm Program. The evening will finish with a forestry question and answer session.

On Sunday participants will enjoy a walk and talk tour of the 2000 Vermont Outstanding Tree Farm, where they will see roads, trails, water crossings, and over 50 years of forestry management on this Tree Farm.

Cost for the weekend workshop is \$100.00 per person, including overnight accommodations and 4 meals, or \$75.00 per person for commuters.
