Cases with Vermont exposure (cases in which it has been determined that infection was likely acquired in Vermont) are noted by county of residence. The number of imported cases (cases in Vermont residents which were determined to have most likely been acquired out of state) are totalled for each year. Unknown cases (cases in which potential exposure could have been both in and out of Vermont) are totalled starting in 2003. Prior to 2003 these cases are included in the number of imported cases.
