VWA Walk in the Woods with Weyerhaeuser and VT ANR up in the Northeast Kingdom

(Bus leaves promptly at 9:00, please arrive early)**

Please join Weyerhaeuser for a woods tour; our theme this year is recreation, in keeping with a focus of Governor Scott. Tour stops include a focus on recreational pedestrian and road access, hiking trails, snowmobile trail relocation, moose browse, trout habitat enhancement, a landscape view stop, an active harvesting operation with a forester explaining the equipment, silviculture and products produced, and a road relocation project.

Attendees will meet in Island Pond behind the old train station at the north end of town (signs will be posted), park there, and ride the bus that will take everyone to the tour locations.

The tour is free. Bring your own lunch, dress for the weather and wear sturdy shoes. Tour hosts will provide cold water, juice, and the bus. Pre-registration is required by September 12th by calling 802-747-7900 or emailing info@vermontwoodlands.org. Tour is limited to 40 participants so sign up today!

Directions:

From the south: drive into town on Routes 114 and 105; at the blinking light look ahead and slightly to the right to find the old train station. **From the west:** drive into town on Route 114; at the blinking light look left and slightly ahead to find the old train station. **From the east:** drive into town on Route 105; just before the blinking light, the old train station will be on your right.
